Dear Chamber Members,



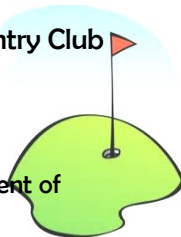
